

**Occupational safety and health – behavior of students  
during the Laboratory Medicine classes**

1. Students obligate to respect principles presented at the occupational safety and health training at the Medical University of Bialystok.
2. Before entering the laboratory room, students are required to wear a protective gown and change their shoes.
3. Students enter the laboratory room only in the presence of the teacher.
4. Only students participating in the classes and the person conducting the classes may stay in the laboratory room. Exiting a laboratory's room can only be done with the teacher's permission.
5. Students must follow the instructions of the teacher.
6. Take special care when moving around the laboratory.
7. Keep quiet, calm and order in the rooms where classes take place.
8. It is forbidden to eat and use cell phones during laboratory classes.
9. Only necessary tools may be present on laboratory tables.
10. Any irregularities and unforeseen events (eg, reagent spillage, instrument damage) must be reported promptly to the class teacher.
11. It is forbidden to take any reagents, preparations and samples from the laboratory.
12. Laboratory devices may be operated under the supervision of the teacher.
13. It is forbidden to perform self-service repairs of equipment and devices.
14. After classes with chemical reagents, students are asked to wash and disinfect their hands.
