

## **INFORMATION ON THE PROCESSING OF PERSONAL DATA CONCERNING VIDEO SURVEILLANCE AT THE MEDICAL UNIVERSITY OF BIALYSTOK**

Pursuant to Art. 13 of Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016 on the protection of individuals with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data, and repealing Directive 95/46/EC, hereinafter referred to as "GDPR" the Medical University of Bialystok informs that:

1. The administrator of your personal data processed in connection with image registration using video surveillance is the Medical University of Bialystok with its registered office in Białystok, ul. Kilińskiego 1, 15-089 Białystok.

3. Video surveillance at the Medical University of Bialystok is carried out to ensure security and order on the premises of the Medical University of Bialystok and to protect people and property.
4. Video surveillance is conducted on the basis of Art. 6 sec. 1 (e) of Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016 on the protection of individuals with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data, and repealing Directive 95/46/EC, hereinafter referred to as "GDPR" in connection with Art. 22<sup>2</sup> the Labor Code.
5. The recipient of the data are companies, which the University has concluded an agreement to entrust data processing to technical support.
6. Your data will be stored for the period of 21 days. The data may be stored longer if the competent authorities request the security of the recorded image in connection with the activities carried out.
7. You are entitled to:
  - the right to access your data,
  - the right to delete data,
  - the right to limit processing or object to processing,

You can exercise your rights by contacting the Data Protection Officer.

8. You have the right to lodge a complaint to the President of the Personal Data Protection Office - when you believe that your personal data is processed in violation of the law.
9. Based on the personal data provided, no automated decisions will be made, including no profiling.
