Academic Biography

Prof. Dr. Nurhan Şahin received her Doctor of Veterinary Medicine (DVM) degree from Fırat University, Faculty of Veterinary Medicine, in 1988. She currently serves as a Professor in the Department of Nutrition at the same faculty. Prof. Sahin has established herself as a leading researcher in the field of animal nutrition, with a particular emphasis on the role of micronutrients (minerals and vitamins) and phytochemical supplements in the prevention of chronic diseases and oxidative stress-related disorders in animal models.

She has authored over **226** peer-reviewed scientific articles published in journals indexed by **Science Citation Index (SCI/SCI-Expanded)**, accumulating more than **11,344 citations** and an **h-index of 64** (Google Scholar). Her research has significantly contributed to the understanding of nutritional strategies for improving health and performance in poultry and other animal species.
