Dear Sir/Madam,

This is to certify that Faculty of Medicine, Medical University of Bialystok, Poland is accredited by the Executive Board of the Medical Council of Thailand in its 13th 2023 meeting, on Dec 14th 2023. This accreditation has validated for 5 year-period during Dec 14th 2023 to Dec 13th 2028. It covers the medical education program, educational management and assigned teaching hospitals as follows:

1. Curriculum:

1. International Program, duration of study: 6 years
2. All instruction is organized in Poland.

2. The teaching hospitals for clinical experiences in Poland as specified in the submitted curriculum as follows:

Main Teaching Hospitals:

1. Medical University of Bialystok Teaching Hospital
2. Medical University of Bialystok Children's Teaching Hospital

Please note that, as per the regulation of the Medical Council of Thailand, medical students must study and complete the curriculum's requirements and all required subjects (except elective period) at Faculty of Medicine, Medical University of Bialystok, Poland.

They must complete clinical clerkship rotations including the final internship under M.D. at the main teaching hospitals as specified in the above item 2.
